SHIFTING/CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14.(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Calicut University Teacher Education Centre, Zamorin's Higher Secondary School, Tali, Calicut, Kerala - 673002** vide order no. F.KL/SE/UNI/N/08/SRO/NCTE/2004-2005/7934 dated 13.10.2004 for **Secondary course** of **one year** duration from the academic session 2004-2005 with an annual intake of 112 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 176 Meeting held on 27th & 28th May, 2009 has considered the matter and decided to issue Withdraw order. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Withdrawal order vide no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2009-2010/14176 dt. 26.06.2009 was issued to the institution.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order no. F.No. 89-778/2009-Appeal dated 06.11.2009 had confirmed the withdrawal order passed by SRC.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed a writ petition no. 33636/2009, 33725/2009, 34110/2009, 33976/2009, 34403/2009, 34402/2009, 34216/2009, 34217/2009, 31218/2009 and 34404/2009 before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala. The Hon'ble Court has passed an order dt. 17.08.2010. The operative part is reproduced below: -

"We direct the NCTE to treat the University Centers as approved centers for the current year 2010-11 also leaving freedom to the NCTE to recall approval if any Centre does not make up facilities pointed out by NCTE in terms of revised orders to be issued in terms of the direction issued above for next academic year (2011-12) onwards."

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the request dt. 06.05.2014 made by the Registrar of Calicut University was considered by the SRC in its 269th Meeting held on 01st & 02nd July, 2014 and decided as under: -

"SRC cannot relax any Regulations as already ruled by the Kerala High Court in its recent order. Further, it is decided by the Committee that these 11 Centers are to be inspected to ascertain their adherence to norms and standards. Southern Regional Office is advised that before causing inspection, however, SRO should collect all documents for verification. Thereafter, after collecting inspection fee of Rs. 50,000/- per center, cause inspection. Hence the University was requested to submit Rs. 50,000/- of inspection fee per center for causing inspection."

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the University had submitted inspection fee and other relevant documents vide its letter dt. 10.09.2014. The reply was considered by the SRC in its 274th Meeting and decided to issue Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution dt 16.01.2015. The institution has submitted a written representation dt. 10.03.2015 on behalf of Show Cause Notice.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 284th Meeting held on 09th & 10th April, 2015 has considered the matter and decided to give time till 31.05.2015.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the following discrepancies came to the notice in the SRC, and the matter was considered by SRC in its 397th Meeting held on 25th & 26th March, 2021 decided as under: -

- (a) *The Teacher Education center all along from the inception has not made serious efforts to comply with NCTE Regulations, Norms & Standards notified from time to time.*
- (b) *Initially Teacher Education center was established in Government Schools and has not made efforts to construct own building. As per NCTE Regulations, an institution should possess its own land and building exclusive to the B.Ed. college. Till date these Teacher Education Centers have not constructed their own building for B.Ed. course which is a clear violation of NCTE Act and its Regulations.*
- (c) *Major changes were made in the NCTE Regulations 2014 wherein one-year B.Ed. course was converted into Two years B.Ed. course. All B.Ed. colleges in the entire country has submitted affidavit to NCTE ensuring to comply with Regulations 2014 and obtained Revised Provisional Regulation order, whereas Calicut University Teacher Education Centers have not cared to submit the Affidavit to comply with NCTE Regulations 2014 till date. Thus, these Teacher Education Centers are not in compliance with NCTE Regulations 2014 which is violation of NCTE Act and its Regulations.*
- (d) *Whenever SRC NCTE has pointed out deficiencies suggesting to improving the facilities, these University Centers have not made serious efforts and after withdrawal of Recognition they always rely upon filing Court cases and never tried to improve facilities. Thus, these Teacher Education Centers all along imparting sub-standard Teacher Education to the students.*
- (e) *Staff requirements as stipulated in Norms & Standards are not maintained. Staff is an important and integral part of quality Teacher Education, whereas these Centers are running with minimal staff thereby compromising the quality of B.Ed. programme.*
- (f) *Since these Teacher Education Centers have neither submitted Affidavit nor obtained Revised Provisional Recognition order from SRC NCTE in the year 2014-2015. Hence, these centers are not an existing institution and they deemed to have lost their existence from the year 2014 itself for not complying to Revised Regulations 2014. These Teacher Education Centers are offering B.Ed. programme illegally from the year 2014 as per the law of the Land.*



(g) Faculty and facilities in these Teacher Education Centers are temporary in nature all along from the establishment of the B.Ed. course. Till date permanent Faculty as per NCTE norms are not appointed by these Centers.

9. **AND WHEREAS**, accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the Registrar, Calicut University of Kerala on 16.04.2021.

10. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 399th Meeting held on 15th & 16th June, 2021 has considered the matter and decided to issue a letter to the University. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the Registrar, Calicut University of Kerala on 23.06.2021.

11. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 400th Meeting held on 13th & 14th July, 2021 has considered the matter and decided to issue the last reminder letter. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a last reminder letter was issued to the Registrar, University of Calicut on 10.08.2021. The University of Calicut vide letter dt. 28.07.2021 had submitted the reply to the letter.

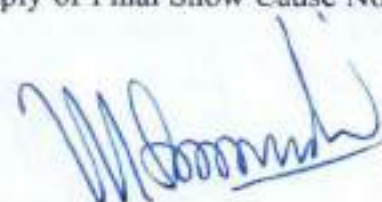
12. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 402nd Meeting held on 13th & 14th September, 2021 has considered the matter and decided to issue a formal order of withdrawal/cancellation of the above programmes. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, withdrawal order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO2949/B.Ed./KL/2021/128898 dt. 27.10.2021 was issued to the institution for B.Ed. programme.

13. **AND WHEREAS**, aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order no. F.No.89-350/E-234018/2021 Appeal/3rd Meeting, 2022 APPLSRC202114235 dated 18.04.2022 was confirmed the order appealed against.

14. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted an Affidavit dt. 29.09.2022 as per the judgement dated 01.09.2022 in the Writ Petition No. 26893 of 2022 of Kerala High Court filed by the University of Calicut and Calicut University Teacher Education Centre, Kozhikode.

15. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 415th Meeting held on 03rd & 04th November, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 22.11.2022. The institution has submitted reply of Show Cause Notice on 06.12.2022.

16. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 426th Meeting held on 23rd June, 2023 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the University. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the University dt. 05.07.2023. The University has submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice vide letter dt. 13.07.2023.



17. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 427th meeting held on 20th July, 2023 has considered the matter and decided to constitute the online VT for shifting of premises and directed the institution to submit the processing fee.

18. **AND WHEREAS**, accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 31.07.2023. The institution has submitted vide letter dated 11.08.2023 Demand Draft of Rs 1,77,000/-. The virtual inspection was conducted on 29.12.2023 and VT report received on 03.01.2024.

19. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 431st Meeting held on 10th January, 2024 has considered the Visiting team report and decided as follows: -

"The original file of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations: -

The Committee on perusal of the reply submitted by the institution namely Calicut University Teacher Education Centre decided that shifting of premises be permitted to the institution at new address i.e., Survey No. 342/2B, R.S. No. 20.13.272, Panniyankara Village, Kerala-673003. The Committee also decided that continuation order be issued to the Institution for B.Ed. programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students."

20. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., Calicut University Teacher Education Centre, Zamorin's Higher Secondary School, Tali, Calicut, Kerala - 673002 to shift its building at new address at Survey No. 342/2B, R.S. No. 20.13.272, Panniyankara Village, Kerala-673003 run by University of Calicut, Malappuram, Kerala. Further as per the decision of the SRC, an order for **continuation of recognition** also issued for B.Ed. course of two years-duration with an annual intake of 1 **basic unit of 50 students** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.



21. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

22. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

23. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

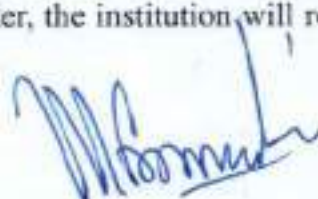
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- e. Fee charged from students.
- f. Available infrastructural facilities.
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

24. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

25. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.

26. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself



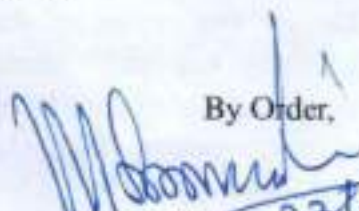
vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
