ORDER

As per the G.Os read as (1) and (2) above, the Government has ordered to effect a 5% enhancement each in the fee and charges of the services rendered by Government Departments, Public Sector/Grant-in-aid institutions w.e.f.01.04.2018 and 01.04.2019 onwards respectively and the G.Os have been implemented in the University vide papers read as (3) and (4) above respectively. However, these hikes were not made applicable in the Self-financing Centres directly run by the University.

2. As per the paper read as (5) above, a Sub Committee with the PVC as Chariman was constituted to revise the fee structure of the Self-financing courses directly run by the University in tune with the additional financial liability incurred upon University due to the revision of salary and wages of the staff of the SF Centres w.e.f.01.06.2017, after assessing the viability of the Centres.

3. As per the paper read as (6) above, the meeting of the Sub Committee held on 30.04.2019 assessed the viability of the various SF Centres and recommended to revise the fee structure of the various Self-financing courses w.e.f.2019 admission onwards and this recommendation was placed before the Syndicate for consideration.

4. As per the paper read as (7) above, the Syndicate has resolved to revise the fee structure of the Self-financing courses directly run by the University with a hike of 10% of the existing fees, in accordance with the Government Orders, as given below:
